STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 359 of the Private and Special Laws of the State of Maine for the year 1903.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. Section 5 of the Private and Special Laws of
2 the state of Maine for the year one thousand nine hundred
3 and three is hereby amended by striking out the entire sec4 tion five and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 5. To carry out the purposes aforesaid said town 6 of York is hereby granted all the rights, powers and privi-7 leges which towns, and their municipal officers, have under 8 the first sixteen sections of chapter twenty-one of the re-9 vised statutes. The assessments set forth in section five 10 of said chapter twenty-one and the sums which the municipal 11 officers shall determine that applicants shall pay for enter-

12 ing and connecting with public sewers and drains as is set 13 forth in section thirteen of said chapter twenty-one may at 14 the discretion of said municipal officers be assessed and 15 determined in one sum against each applicant or person or 16 corporation liable to pay the same, and be made payable in 17 one sum or made payable in annual instalments extending 18 over a term of years not exceeding ten years from the date 19 of said assessment or said determination. A failure to pay 20 when due any one of the instalments of said assessment or 21 determination shall render the person or corporation liable 22 to pay as aforesaid, and the property on which the lien there-23 for exists subject to all the provisions of said chapter twen-24 ty-one as to the enforcement of payment and lien. Any 25 person other than an abuttor who wishes to enter and con-26 nect his private drain or sewer with a public drain or 27 sewer who makes written application therefor to the mu-28 nicipal officers, may so enter and connect by paying the town 29 treasurer such a sum as the municipal officers shall deem 30 expedient and reasonable, and such applicant shall receive a 31 written permit signed by at least a majority of the municipal 32 officers, stating the amount to be paid, the right so to enter, 33 the place and manner of such entry and connection. Said 34 applicant shall at all times maintain said private sewer or 35 drain to its connection with said public sewer or drain with-36 out expense, loss or damage to said town of York.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
