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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter twenty-eight and one hundred seventy-five of the Public Laws of 1907, relating to the terms of the Supreme Judicial Court in Aroostook County.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, 2 as amended by chapter 28 and 175 of the Public Laws of 3 1907 is hereby amended by striking out all of the third para- 4 graph of section 51 of said chapter 79, and inserting in its 5 stead the following:

'Aroostook at Houlton on the first Tuesday of April, and 7 the third Tuesday of November, for civil and criminal busi-

8 ness, and at Caribou on the first Tuesday of February and  
9 the third Tuesday of September for civil business only. All  
10 civil suits and processes which by law should have been en-  
11 tered at the term of the said supreme court next after this  
12 act takes effect, shall be returnable to, and be entered on the  
13 docket of the said Supreme Judicial Court at the September  
14 term of same holden next after this act takes effect, and shall  
15 have day in said Supreme Judicial Court, and be heard and  
16 disposed of as if originally entered therein, and all indict-  
17 ments and informations, and all parties, grand juries, wit-  
18 nesses and others who have been held to appear at the term  
19 of said Supreme Court which but for the passage of this act  
20 would have been held in Houlton in September, 1911, shall  
21 be holden to appear at the term of said Supreme Judicial  
22 Court to be held at Houlton in said county, in November  
23 next after this act takes effect.'

Sect. 2. Said chapter 28 and 175 of the Public Laws of  
2 1907, and all other acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent here-  
3 with, are hereby repealed.
