STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the construction of a wharf into the tide
waters of Casco Bay in the Town of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Concord Realty Company, a corporation
2 organized and existing under the laws of the State of New
3 York and having an office and place of business in Port-
4 land in the County of Cumberland and State of Maine, its
5 successors or assigns, as the owner of certain real estate
6 in the town of Cumberland is hereby authorized to con-
7 struct and maintain a private wharf therefrom into the tide
8 waters of Casco Bay.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
