STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the Town of York to lease certain lands
within said town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of preserving and improving
2 the natural scenery along the highways and townways in
3 the Town of York, the inhabitants of said town are hereby
4 authorized to acquire by lease, any tract of woodland lying
5 along any of the highways or townways in said town on
6 such terms and conditions as the owners thereof, and said
7 inhabitants may agree, but in no case shall payment amount
8 to more than three and one-half per cent. of the value of
9 said property per annum.

Sect. 2. Said inhabitants are hereby authorized to make

2 such appropriation as they may deem advisable for the
3 purposes aforesaid.

Sect. 3. Said inhabitants are hereby further authorized
2 to make such arrangements for the care and protection of
3 lands so leased as they may deem advisable.
