Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of sixty-two dollars and twenty-nine cents to be paid 3 to Holden Brothers of Jackman for boats and board fur-4 nished for fighting forest fires in the fall of 1908.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This claim has not been paid for the reason that it was not before the legislature of 1909 to go along with the general deficiency bill for forest fires in the fall of 1908.

The detailed account is attached to this statement as a part of it, and is supported by affidavit of Fire Warden Albert Mc-Daniels.
