STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter nine of the Revised Statutes relative to the property of public municipal corporations situated outside their corporate limits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Sub-section one of section six of chapter nine 2 of the Revised Statutes of Maine is hereby amended by adding 3 after the word "uses" at the end of said sub-section the 4 following: 'If located within the corporate limits and confines 5 of such public municipal corporation,' so that said section 6 as amended will read as follows:

'Sect. 6. The following property and polls are exempt 8 from taxation:

1. The property of the United States and of this State,
10 and the property of any public municipal corporation of this
11 state appropriated to public uses if located within the cor-
12 porate limits and confines of such public municipal corpora-
13 tion.'
