STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Machiasport and East Machias
Bridge.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the year 1911
3 and five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the year 1912, to be
4 paid to the trustees of the Machiasport and East Machias
5 Bridge, for the purpose of assisting in the completion of
6 said bridge.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On account of the bridge not being completed and the fact that piers should be erected for the protection of the bridge in winter from ice, together with other expenses, and as this bridge is a general benefit to the traveling public of Washington county, the towns of Machiasport and East Machias ask this assistance.
