IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the construction of a bridge across the  
Piscataqua River.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Authority is hereby granted to the city of  
2 Portsmouth in the town of Rockingham, state of New  
3 Hampshire, and the town of Kittery, either or both of them  
4 to construct a bridge across the Piscataqua river at such a  
5 place and of such material and design as the secretary of  
6 war and Congress may hereafter approve.

Sect. 2. In lieu of building a new bridge, either or both  
2 of the above municipalities are authorized to lease any exist-  
3 ing bridge over said Piscataqua river.
