STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the construction of a bridge across the Piscataqua River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Authority is hereby granted to the city of
Portsmouth in the town of Rockingham, state of New
Hampshire, and the town of Kittery, either or both of them
to construct a bridge across the Piscataqua river at such a
place and of such material and design as the secretary of
war and Congress may hereafter approve.

Sect. 2. In lieu of building a new bridge, either or both 2 of the above municipalities are authorized to lease any exist-3 ing bridge over said Piscataqua river.
