## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing Kingsbury Plantation to build and maintain its roads and bridges, and to raise money for the same.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The municipal officers of Kingsbury plantation
2 in the county of Piscataquis, are hereby given all the powers
3 of municipal officers of towns to lay out, alter, widen, or
4 repair public or private ways within said plantation, and to
5 assess and expend such sums of money as the said plan6 tation may at its annual meeting raise therefor, in all re7 spects as the municipal officers of towns may do; and so
8 far as applicable the provisions of chapter twenty-three of
9 the revised statutes shall apply to laying out, extending,
10 altering, or repairing public or private ways in said planta-

11 tion; and all the powers which towns now have to raise and 12 expend money for the purpose of making and repairing 13 ways, building bridges, and paying officers and agents, are 14 hereby extended to said plantation.
