STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Kibbie Dam Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 4 of Chapter 357 of the Private and Special Laws
2 of the State of Maine for the year 1903 be amended as
3 follows:

By striking out the word "forty-five" in the fifth line of
5 said section and substituting therefor the word 'fifty-five';
6 by striking out the word "thirty-five" in the eighth and ninth
7 lines of said section and substituting therefor the word
8 'forty-five'; by striking out the word "twenty-five" in the
9 thirteenth line of said section and substituting therefor the
10 word 'thirty-five'; by striking out the word "fifteen" in the
11 fifteenth line of said section and substituting therefor the
12 word 'twenty-five'; by striking out the word "ten" in the

13 eighteenth line of said section and substituting therefor the
14 word 'twenty.'

So that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. Said company may demand and receive tolls for
17 the passage of all logs and lumber over their dams and im-
18 provements as follows: For all logs and lumber landed in
19 said Kibbie stream above the upper West Branch dam, a
20 sum not exceeding fifty-five cents per thousand feet; for
21 all logs and lumber landed on said stream between said upper
22 West Branch dam and the north line of the Rockwood
23 Strip, so called, in Kibbie Township, a sum not exceeding
24 forty-five cents per thousand feet; for all logs and lumber
25 landed on said stream between said north line of the Rock-
26 wood Strip and the flowage line of lower Kibbie dam, situ-
27 ated near the west line of township four, range five, a sum
28 not exceeding thirty-five cents per thousand feet; for all
29 logs and lumber landed in said stream between said flowage
30 line and lower Kibbie dam, a sum not exceeding twenty-five
31 cents per thousand feet; and for all logs and lumber landed
32 on said stream between said lower Kibbie dam and the
33 mouth of Kibbie stream, a sum not exceeding twenty cents
34 per thousand feet. All the above tolls to be reckoned at
35 the survey or scale adopted by the Kennebec Log Driving
36 Company. Said Kibbie Dam Company shall have a lien
37 upon all logs and lumber which may pass over any of its
38 dams and improvements until the full amount of tolls is
39 paid; but the logs of each particular mark shall only be

40 holden to pay the toll on such mark; and if said toll is not
41 paid within thirty days after said logs or lumber, or the
42 major part thereof, shall have arrived within the limits of
43 the Kennebec Log Driving Company, said Kibbie Dam Com-
44 pany may seize, hold and sell at public auction such part of
45 said logs or lumber as shall be necessary to pay such tolls,
46 with all incidental costs and charges thereon, after ten days'
47 notice in writing of the time and place of said sale given to
48 the owner of such logs or lumber.'
