## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT establishing a close time on lobsters in the waters of Winter Harbor, in Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall take, catch, kill or destroy any

- 2 lobsters between the first day of July and the first day of
- 3 September in each year under a penalty of one dollar for
- 4 each lobster so taken, caught, killed or destroyed; and five
- 5 dollars for each lobster trap set in all the waters of Winter
- 6 Harbor in said Hancock county inside of a direct line from
- 7 Schoodick Island whistling buoy, northwest by west to Egg
- 8 Rock whistling buoy, thence northeast by north to Jordans
- 9 Island bar.
  - Sect. 2. This act shall not prohibit the catching, taking,

- 2 shipping or otherwise handling lobsters that are caught out-3 side these bounds, or held in cars or pounds.
- Sect. 3. All fines and penalties under this act may be re-2 covered as provided in section forty-eight of chapter two 3 hundred and eighty-five of the public laws of eighteen hun-
- 4 dred and ninety-seven.
