STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Mattanawcook Academy.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred 3 and eleven for Mattanawcook academy in the town of Lin-4 coln, this being the additional amount due that town for 5 academy aid for the year ending July one, nineteen hundred 6 and nine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In relation to the accompanying resolve in favor of Mattanawcook academy the following statement of facts is given:

In making the apportionment of academy aid for the year ending July one, nineteen hundred and nine, a certificate for five hundred dollars in favor of Mattanawcook academy was forwarded to the governor and council and warrant for that amount was drawn. The return filed by the officers of the academy show that that academy so met the conditions of section seventy-six of chapter fifteen of the revised statutes as to be entitled to aid amounting to one thousand dollars. It is, therefore, earnestly recommended that the balance of five hundred dollars due be authorized to be paid at this time.
