STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the town of St. George.

Resolved, That the sum of seven hundred and six dollars
2 is hereby appropriated to be paid to the town of St. George,
3 to reimburse said town for expense of supporting Maria
4 Johnson and family prior to the year 1909.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Maria Johnson and family are state paupers, and the town of St. George has been reimbursed by the state for their support since January 1st, 1909. Bills for their support prior to that time were not filed in the usual manner for the reason that the municipal officers had not ascertained that the state was liable. Affidavits are now on file, clearly establishing the liability of the state for support of this family.
