STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the town of East Livermore.

Resolved. That the sum of five hundred and twenty-five

- 2 dollars and twenty-one cents be and is hereby appropriated
- 3 to be paid to the town of East Livermore, to reimburse said
- 4 town for money expended for support of state paupers, as
- 5 follows: For support of Mrs. Louis Fortier, three hundred
- 6 and seven dollars and forty-nine cents; for support of Napo-
- 7 leon Carter and family, two hundred and seventeen dollars
- 8 and seventy-two cents, for the years 1908 and 1909.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mrs. Louis Fortier and Napoleon Carter and family are state paupers under the provisions of the alien law (Chapter 142 of the Public Laws of 1905). These claims were not filed with the Governor and Council at the usual time for the reason that the alien law was not interpreted by the Law Court until February, 1910. Prior to that time it was not definitely known that the state was liable for support of all alien paupers. The money asked for under this resolve was expended for the support of said paupers in 1908 and 1909; nearly all of it in 1909.
