STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the rights, powers and privileges of the
Barrows Falls Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Bar-
rows Falls Light and Power Company which were granted
by chapter two hundred and sixty-three of the private and
special laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and
nine, are hereby extended for and during the period of two
years from March twenty-fourth, nineteen hundred and
eleven, and all the rights, powers and privileges that were
granted by said act may and shall be exercised in the same
manner and for the same purposes provided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
