#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing Booth Brothers and Hurricane Isle Granite Co. to construct and maintain a railroad crossing or crossings in the town of St. George.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Booth Brothers and Hurricane Isle Granite Co.,

- 2 a corporation organized under the laws of the state of New
- 3 York, and having an established place of business in Saint
- 4 George in the county of Knox and state of Maine, is hereby
- 5 authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a rail-
- 6 road crossing, or crossings, at grade, over and across any
- 7 highway in that part of Saint George known as Long Cove,
- 8 said crossing or crossings to be built at such grade and under
- 9 such conditions as may be prescribed by the railroad com-
- 10 missioners of the state of Maine.
