STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of John Holden and Company.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of one hundred and thirty-two dollars and fifty-seven 3 cents (\$132.57) to be paid to John Holden and Company 4 for supplies furnished fire wardens, and cash paid men for 5 fighting forest fires in the fall of 1908.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This claim was not paid for the reason that it was not before the Legislature of 1909 to go along with the general deficiency bill for forest fires in the fall of 1908. The bill hereto attached as a part of this statement is accompanied for vouchers for payments, and by affidavits of Fire Warden Albert McDaniels.
