STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 6 of Chapter 128, relating to malicious mischiefs and trespasses on property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 of Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "maliciously" in the first line, the following: 'breaks the seal upon any freight car or,' so that said section, as amended, will read as follows:

'Sect. 6. Whoever wilfully, mischievously, or maliciously breaks the seal upon any freight car, or breaks and enters any railroad car on any railroad in the state, or destroys, injures, defiles or defaces any railroad car on any railroad in the state, or mischievously or maliciously releases the brakes

11 upon, moves or sets in motion any railroad car on the track
12 or side track of any railroad in the state, shall be punished
13 by imprisonment not exceeding two years, or by fine not
14 exceeding five hundred dollars, and shall also be liable to
15 the corporation injured in an action of trespass for the
16 amount of injury so done, and for a further sum not ex-
17 ceeding in all three times such amount, as the jury deems
18 reasonable.'
