STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Maine Industrial School for Girls for maintenance and deficiency.

Resolved: That there be and is hereby appropriated the

- 2 sum of twenty-three thousand dollars for the Maine Indus-
- 3 trial School for Girls for maintenance for nineteen hundred
- 4 and eleven. Same to be expended under the direction of the
- 5 board of trustees of said school.

That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of two

- 7 thousand two hundred and thirty-seven dollars and nine cents
- 8 for deficiency (actual) for 1909 and 1910. *

That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of twen-10 ty-three thousand dollars for the Maine Industrial School for 11 Girls, same to be expended under the direction of the board 12 of trustees of said school for maintenance and general ex-13 penses for nineteen hundred and twelve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The committee decided that \$25,237.09 would cover general expense of the school and the \$3,000 deficiency of nineteen hundred and ten. Also that \$23,000 would cover the general expense of the school of nineteen hundred and twelve, thus making for the three resolves above a total of \$48,237.09.
