STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Maine Industrial School for Girls, for permanent improvements and general repairs.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for the 2 year nineteen hundred and eleven the sum of twenty-three 3 hundred dollars for the Maine Industrial School for Girls, 4 the same to be expended by and under the direction of the 5 board of trustees of said school for permanent improve- 6 ments and general repairs at the school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The amount requested in this resolve is desired for general repairs and permanent improvements on the buildings distributed as follows:

Erskine	600
Baker	500
Barn	200

The committee decided that the repairs on the Steward's house and barn, and also the grading, all amounting to thirty-seven hundred, could be put off two years longer without injury to the institution.
