STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Nigger Brook Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. William J. Robbins, Alexis O. Robbins, Lu-
2 cinda J. Robbins, Julia A. Robbins, Lowell W. Rollins and
3 Edna M. Rollins, their associates, successors and assigns are
4 hereby incorporated under the name of the Nigger Brook
5 Power Company for the purpose of furnishing power to the
6 Fort Kent Electric Company for electric lighting purposes.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is authorized to locate, construct
2 and maintain a dam at Nigger Brook Falls on Nigger Brook
3 Stream in Aroostook County, also a dam at the outlet of
4 Third Lake, so called, and a dam at the outlet of Fourth
5 Lake, so called, the two latter being in the southwest quar-

6 ter of township sixteen, range nine, in said county of Aroos-
7 took, provided said corporation shall purchase, lease or oth-
8 erwise acquire from the owner or owners thereof the land on
9 which said two last mentioned dams are located.

Sect. 3. The capital stock of said corporation shall be ten
2 thousand dollars, which shall be paid in or be subscribed for
3 in good faith before the company shall flow any lands not
4 belonging to said company. Said company shall have power
5 to issue bonds for such amounts as may be required and se-
6 cure said bonds by mortgages upon the property and fran-
7 chises of the company.

Sect. 4. Suitable sluice-ways for log driving purposes
2 shall be constructed and maintained by said company until
3 June twentieth of each year and the owner of any logs to be
4 floated down said brook shall have the right before said date
5 to open said sluices and use the water stored thereby for
6 floating said logs.

Sect. 5. All damages, sustained by reason of flowage un-
2 less otherwise agreed upon shall be determined according
3 to the laws regulating flowage damages.

Sect. 6. The first meeting of said corporation may be called
2 by a written notice thereof signed by any incorporator here-
3 in named and served in hand or mailed postage paid at least
4 seven days prior to the day named therein for such meeting,
5 unless notice is waived in writing by all the incorporators.
