STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and forty-two of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five relating to support of alien paupers.

Whereas, under the provisions of chapter 142 of the Public Laws of 1905 an expense is placed upon the state which, under present conditions, it is not able to bear without resorting to extraordinary taxation, and

Whereas, in the opinion of the legislature, this fact renders the immediate passage of this act necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and constitute an emergency within the meaning of the constitution, now therefore, Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and forty-two of the Pub
lic Laws of nineteen hundred and five is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
