STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls,
for water supply.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred
3 and eleven for the Maine Industrial School for Girls, the
4 same to be expended by and under the direction of the board
5 of trustees of said school for the water supply.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The committee decided that one thousand dollars would be adequate for improvement of the water supply.
