STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred twenty-five of the Public Laws of 1909 relating to expenses of the inspector of boilers and engines and their appurtenances of steamboats upon inland waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and twenty-five of the

Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby repealed.
