and Lower Richardson lakes, with statement of facts.

Resolved: That the sum of fifty dollars be and is hereby
2 appropriated for the year 1911, also fifty dollars for the year
3 1912, to be expended under the direction of the steamboat
4 inspectors, for maintaining lights on the buoys in Upper and
5 Lower Richardson lakes.
