STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in aid of navigation on Rangeley Lake, Mooselucmeguntic Lake and Cupsuptic Lake.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for removing obstructions and for the placing of buoys in Rangeley lake, Mooselucmeguntic lake and Cup-4 suptic lake and for the erection of lights in Rangeley lake, Mooselucmeguntic lake and Cupsuptic lake and maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and twelve. Said buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in said lakes as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon. All said moneys shall be expended under the direction of state steam-11 boot inspectors. Any part of the money hereby appropriated for removing obstructions, for the placing of buoys and lights and maintenance of lights which shall be unex-14 pended at the end of the year nineteen hundred and twelve shall revert to the state.
