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STATE OF MAINE

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RESOLVE in aid of navigation on Rangeley Lake, Moose-  
lucmeguntic Lake and Cupsuptic Lake.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred dollars is hereby  
2 appropriated for removing obstructions and for the placing  
3 of buoys in Rangeley lake, Mooselucmeguntic lake and Cup-  
4 suptic lake and for the erection of lights in Rangeley lake,  
5 Mooselucmeguntic lake and Cupsuptic lake and maintenance  
6 of the same for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and  
7 a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and twelve. Said  
8 buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in said lakes  
9 as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon. All said  
10 moneys shall be expended under the direction of state steam-  
11 boat inspectors. Any part of the money hereby appropri-  
12 ated for removing obstructions, for the placing of buoys  
13 and lights and maintenance of lights which shall be unex-  
14 pended at the end of the year nineteen hundred and twelve  
15 shall revert to the state.
