STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter Eighty-five, Section Six, of the Reised Statutes relating to Municipal and Police Courts, their jurisdiction and proceedings in civil actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section six, of Chapter eighty-five, of the Re-

- 2 vised Statutes, is hereby amended by inserting the word
- 3 'five' after the word "sixty" and before the word "days" in
- 4 the third line of said Section so that said Section as amend-
- 5- ed shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 6. Writs in civil actions before any municipal or
- 7 police court may be made returnable at any term thereof,
- 8 to be held not less than seven, nor more than sixty-five days
- 9 from their date.'
