STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Eastport Street Railway
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the East-
2 port Street Railway Company which were granted by Chap-
3 ter four hundred and sixty-five of the Private and Special
4 Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and extended
5 by Chapter one hundred and seventeen of the Private and
6 Special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and fur-
7 ther extended by Chapter two hundred and sixty-eight of
8 the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one,
9 and further extended by Chapter two hundred and sixty-
10 four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred

11 and three, and further extended by Chapter one hundred
12 and thirteen of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
13 hundred and five, and further extended by Chapter two
14 hundred and twenty-five of the Private and Special Laws
15 of nineteen hundred and seven, and further extended by
16 Chapter one hundred and forty-six of the Private and Spe-
17 cial Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, are hereby fur-
18 ther extended for and during the period of two years from
19 the seventeenth day of March, in the year of our Lord
20 nineteen hundred and eleven, and all the rights, powers,
21 privileges and franchises that were granted and have been
22 acquired by virtue of or under said acts may and shall be
23 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as
24 provided in said Chapter four hundred and sixty-five.
