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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend the charter of the Livermore Falls Sewer  
District, for the better collection of taxes.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section eleven of Chapter 289 of the Private  
2 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and seven is hereby  
3 amended by inserting in the sixth line, of said Section, after  
4 the word collected, the words, 'the valuation of said prop-  
5 erty, within the district, may be assessed by the trustees.  
6 or taken from the assessor's books within the district of  
7 the town of East Livermore, for the year said property is  
8 to be assessed. The trustee's may appoint a collector for  
9 the collection of all taxes assessed on the property within  
10 said district, and the collector may bring suit, in the name

11 of the inhabitants of said district on any unpaid taxes with-  
12 in ten days, after notice is given to the property holder of  
13 the amount of said tax.

‘The assessment of a tax on any property within the dis-  
15 trict, will create a lien on said property for one year from  
16 assessment, and said property may be advertised and sold  
17 for the payment of said taxes,’ so that said section when  
18 amended, shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 11. At any time should the income of said district  
20 be insufficient to meet all the obligations set forth in Sec-  
21 tion ten of this act, the whole or any part of this deficit  
22 may be raised by taxation; which tax shall be assessed  
23 and collected, on the property within the district, in the  
24 same manner as municipal taxes are assessed and collected,  
25 the valuation of said property within the district, may be  
26 assessed by the trustees, or taken from the Assessors books,  
27 within the district, of the town of East Livermore, for the  
28 year said property is to be assessed.

The trustees may appoint a collector for the collection of  
30 all taxes assessed on the property, within said district, and  
31 the collector may bring suit, in the name of the inhabitants  
32 of said district, on any unpaid taxes within ten days after  
33 notice is given to the property holder, for the amount of  
34 taxes due. The assessment of a tax on any property with-  
35 in the district, will create a lien on said property for one  
36 year from assessment, and said property may be advertised  
37 and sold for the payment of said taxes.
