STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to provide for the better preservation of township plans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Chapter eleven of the Revised Statutes, re-2 lating to register of deeds is hereby amended by adding 3 thereto the following section.

'Sect. 20. The aldermen of cities and the selectmen of 5 towns may cause any plans in the possession of said cities 6 or towns or otherwise available, showing the allotment of 7 lands in said cities or towns, to be recorded in the registry 8 of deeds in and for the county wherein any such city or 9 town may be situated. Said plans to be transcribed or 10 copied upon the best quality mounted drawing paper in a

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11 suitable book furnished by the register at the expense of 12 the county.

Said aldermen or selectmen shall on the written request of 14 three or more freeholders of any such city or town, cause 15 such plans to be recorded as herein provided. The register 16 shall certify the record or copy of said plan for which he 17 shall receive a fee of fifty cents to be paid by the city or 18 town presenting such plan for record. Said city or town 19 shall also pay in addition to the above the cost of copying or 20 transcribing said plan on the record.
