STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter six hundred and thirteen of the
Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
three, as amended by chapter one hundred of the Private and
Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled "An Act
to establish the Western Hancock Municipal Court."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section nine of chapter six hundred and thir-
2 teen of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred
3 and ninety-three as amended by chapter one hundred of the
4 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three is
5 hereby further amended by striking out the word "Bluehill"
6 in the fourth line thereof and inserting in the place thereof
7 the word 'Deer Isle,' and by striking out the word "Deer

8 Isle” in the ninth line thereof and inserting in the place there-
9 of the word ‘Bluehill,’ so that said section as amended, shall
10 read as follows:

‘Sect. 9. A term of said court shall be held for the transac-
12 tion of civil business as follows: On the second Tuesday of
13 each of the months of January, March, July and September
14 in the town of Deer Isle. On the second Tuesday of each
15 of the months of February, May, June, August, November
16 and December in the town of Bucksport. On the fourth
17 Tuesday of each of the months of January, February, March,
18 April, May, July, September, October, November and De-
19 cember in the town of Bluehill. On the fourth Tuesday of
20 the months of June and August in the town of Castine. Be-
21 ginning at ten o’clock in the forenoon at such place in either
22 of the towns named in this section, as the judge shall deter-
23 mine. For the cognizance and trial of criminal actions said
24 court shall be considered in constant session. In all cases
25 it may be adjourned from time to time by the judge.’
