IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the State Land Agent to sell certain property of the state at the Belgrade Fish Hatchery, in the county of Kennebec.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The State Land Agent is hereby authorized to  
2 sell, under the direction of the Governor and Council, at  
3 public auction, to the highest bidder, after advertising, the  
4 farm at the Belgrade Fish Hatchery, the proceeds of said  
5 sale to be paid to the State Treasurer, and shall be used by  
6 the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game for the  
7 erection of a dwelling house for the superintendent at the  
8 Monmouth Fish Hatchery and for finishing the second story  
9 of the hatchery building at Belgrade, so that said second

10 story may be used as a dwelling by the superintendent of said  
11 hatchery.

If the amount received from the sale of said farm is not  
13 sufficient to complete the contemplated cottage at the Mon-  
14 mouth Hatchery and to finish the second story of the Bel-  
15 grade Hatchery Building for a dwelling, said Commissioners  
16 of Inland Fisheries and Game are authorized to use sufficient  
17 funds to complete this work properly from the amount ap-  
18 propriated for the operation of the fish hatcheries of the  
19 State and for the protection of fish, game and birds.
