STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 179 of the Private and Special Laws of 1905, relating to fishing in Marble brook, and Marble pond, so-called, tributary waters to the Piscataquis river, situated partly in the town of Blanchard, county of Piscataquis, and in Chase brook, some times called Blackstone brook, also situated partly in said Blanchard.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of Section 1 of Chapter 179 of the
2 Private and Special Laws of 1905 as prohibits fishing in
3 Marble brook and in Marble pond, so-called, tributary wa-
4 ters to the Piscataquis river, situated partly in the town of
5 Blanchard, in the county of Piscataquis, and in Chase brook,

6 sometimes called Blackstone brook, also situated partly in
7 said Blanchard, in accordance with the general law of the
8 State, is hereby repealed.
