AN ACT to regulate fishing in Abbott pond, so-called, in the  
town of Sumner, County of Oxford.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch  
2 or kill any kind of fish at any time in Abbott pond, so-  
3 called, in the town of Sumner, county of Oxford, from  
4 September first of each year until June first of the following  
5 year.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall  
2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general  
3 law of the state for the illegal taking, catching, killing or  
4 having in possession of trout or land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, mu-

2 nicipal and police courts and trial justices, within their re-  
3 spective counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and  
4 concurrent jurisdiction with the Supreme Judicial and Su-  
5 perior Courts, and all fines, forfeitures, and penalties re-  
6 ceived for any violation of this act shall be paid forth-  
7 with by the person receiving the same to the state treasurer.
