#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Abbott pond, so-called, in the town of Sumner, County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch
2 or kill any kind of fish at any time in Abbott pond, so3 called, in the town of Sumner, county of Oxford, from
4 September first of each year until June first of the following
5 year.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general 3 law of the state for the illegal taking, catching, killing or 4 having in possession of trout or land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, mu-

2 nicipal and police courts and trial justices, within their re3 spective counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and
4 concurrent jurisdiction with the Supreme Judicial and Su5 perior Courts, and all fines, forfeitures, and penalties re6 ceived for any violation of this act shall be paid forth7 with by the person receiving the same to the state treasurer.
