STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 213 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909 relating to fishing in Belgrade stream, in Kennebec county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of Chapter 213 of the Private and

2 Special Laws of 1909 as permits fishing in Belgrade stream

3 from Wing's mill dam, so-called, to a point two hundred

4 feet below Belgrade bridge, so-called, on said stream, is

5 hereby repealed.
