STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the trapping of Beaver and Muskrat.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. During any open season in any place for beaver
2 or for muskrat it shall be unlawful at any time for any per-
3 son to set a trap for beaver or for muskrat within ten feet
4 of a beaver house of a muskrat house.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act re-
2 lating to beaver shall be subject to a penalty of twenty-five
3 dollars and costs for each beaver taken, caught or killed in
4 violation of any provision of this act; it shall also be un-
5 lawful, under the same penalty, to have in possession any
6 beaver, or part thereof, taken in violation of any provision
7 of this act. Whoever violates any provision of this act re-
8 lating to muskrat shall be subject to a penalty of ten dollars

9 and costs for each muskrat taken, caught, or killed in viola-
10 tion of any provision of this act; it shall also be unlawful,
11 under the same penalty, to have in possession any muskrat,
12 or part thereof, taken in violation of any provision of this
13 act.
