STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the disposal of fish and game seized by the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game or any officials empowered so to do.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game
2 or other persons having the power to seize fish and game
3 shall sell or offer the same for sale.

- Sect. 2. That all fish and game seized by the aforenamed
- 2 officials shall be distributed among the various State hos-
- 3 pitals or other charitable institutions under the direction of
- 4 the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game.
- Sect. 3. That a record shall be kept by said Commissioners 2 of all fish or game seized.
 - Sect. 4. That a record shall be kept by said commissioners

- 2 where all fish or game seized, has been distributed, and that 3 a receipt shall be taken for the same from the proper official
- 4 of the institution receiving said fish or game.
- Sect. 5. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
