STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

- AN ACT to protect lobsters in the waters adjacent to the shores of the towns of Lubec and Trescott as amended by Chapter three hundred seventy-nine of the Special Laws of 1907 be repealed.
- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Chapter three hundred and seventeen of the
 2 Special Laws of 1901, entitled, An Act to protect lobsters in
 3 the waters adjacent to the shores of the towns of Lubec
 4 and Trescott as amended by Chapter three hundred and sev5 enty-nine of the Special Laws of 1907, is hereby repealed.
