STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT additional to Chapter 144 of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. If a woman is committed to either of the insane

- 2 hospitals under the provisions of Chapter one hundred forty-
- 3 four of the Revised Statutes the magistrate or magistrates
- 4 committing her shall, unless she is to be accompanied by a
- 5 father, husband, brother or son designate a woman to be an
- 6 attendant or one of the attendants to accompany her thereto.
