AN ACT additional to Chapter 144 of the Revised Statutes.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. If a woman is committed to either of the insane  
2 hospitals under the provisions of Chapter one hundred forty-  
3 four of the Revised Statutes the magistrate or magistrates  
4 committing her shall, unless she is to be accompanied by a  
5 father, husband, brother or son designate a woman to be an  
6 attendant or one of the attendants to accompany her thereto.
