STATEMENT OF FACTS TO ACCOMPANY HOUSE
DOCUMENT NO. 361.

STATE OF MAINE

“Resolve in favor of repairing the road known as the Lake Road, in Township C and C Surplus, in Oxford County.”

This road is a county road and was built about thirty-five years ago. It is between seven and eight miles through these two townships. There are no clearings along the road. There is a stage that runs regularly into the South Arm of Richardson Lake to connect with Captain Coburn's steamboat. These two townships were assessed a State tax of about three thousand dollars in nineteen hundred ten and have always paid a good-sized State tax, and the State has never been asked to help before on this road. It is no more than right that once in a while that this road should be assisted by the State as long as it receives the taxes from these townships, and has no schools or other roads to maintain.
