STATE OF MAINE

Samoille Wan came to Island Falls in July, 1906, in company with 25 Hungarians, from Boston, to work on a tannery situated there. He remained there until December, 1906, when he was taken insane and was committed to the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, where he died on the 25th day of March, 1909. The town having paid the expenses of his commitment and board there, and other supplies furnished him, amounting to \$578.99, respectfully asks that this amount be refunded to them by reason of the fact that said Samoille Wan, being an alien, could not have a pauper residence in any town in the State of Maine.
