STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 42 of Chapter 141 of the Revised Statutes of 1903, relating to the punishment of convicts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-two of Chapter one hundred and

- 2 forty-one of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and
- 3 three is hereby amended by adding to said Section the fol-
- 4 lowing words: 'and any county farm that may be estab-
- 5 lished for the reformation of inebriates,' so that said Sec-
- 6 tion shall read as follows:

'Sect. 42. The four preceeding Sections apply to convicts

- 8 and officers in the county jails having workshops attached
- 9 thereto and any county farm that may be established for
- 10 the reformation of inebriates.'
