STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to ratify the organization, acts and doing and extend
the powers of the Georges River Land Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The organization of the Georges River Land
2 Company, a corporation created by Chapter two hundred
3 and twenty three of the Private and Special Laws of one
4 thousand eight hundred and ninety one, duly existing un-
5 der the laws of the State of Maine, is hereby ratified, con-
6 firmed and declared to be legal and valid, and the surviving
7 members and officers have authority to hold a meeting on
8 call of the President giving seven days' notice, and then
9 elect new officers, and amend or make new by-laws; and

10 the clerk elected at such meeting shall have authority to
11 complete the records of the deceased clerk.

Sect. 2. Section three of said act is hereby amended by
2 striking out the words "or for those desiring to use the
3 same" after the word "property" in the twenty-fifth line.
4 The rights, powers and authority of the said corporation
5 as granted in said Chapter two hundred and twenty three
6 of Private and Special Laws of 1891 as amended, are here-
7 by extended and granted to the new officers and members
8 and their associates and successors; and said corporation
9 is hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds secured
10 by its property.
