STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend an act authorizing the Penobscot Chemical
Fibre Company to generate, use, transmit and sell electricity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 287 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1907, entitled:

An Act to amend Section one of Chapter one hundred
4 forty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
5 hundred and five, entitled An Act to amend Section one
6 of Chapter eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of
7 nineteen hundred and three, entitled An Act to authorize
8 the Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company to make, generate,
9 use, transmit and sell electricity, is hereby amended by
10 inserting after the word "Bradley" in the fourth, twenty-
11 second and thirty-third lines the words 'and between the

12 towns of Orono and Bradley' so that said Section as amend-
13 ed shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company is
15 hereby specially authorized and empowered to make and
16 generate electricity upon its property situated upon the Pe-
17 nobscot river between the towns of Old Town and Bradley,
18 and between the towns of Orono and Bradley, and also on
19 any dam or dams which it has or may erect on its property
20 situated on said Penobscot river as aforesaid and to use
21 said electricity as a motive power in the use and develop-
22 ment of its property, and also to sell the same for mechan-
23 ical, manufacturing and heating purposes, and to sell the
24 same for lighting purposes to any company authorized to do
25 a general lighting business, or that may hereafter be author-
26 ized to do a general lighting business, and where power is
27 sold to persons, firms or corporations for manufacturing
28 purposes to sell the same to said persons, firms or corpora-
29 tions in connection therewith for lighting the premises own-
30 ed or occupied by said persons, firms or corporations, and to
31 sell the same to persons or firms desiring to do an electrical
32 lighting business in the towns of Bradley and Hampden
33 in Penobscot county, and to sell the same for motor power
34 in the operation of any and all electric and steam railways,
35 and also to carry and conduct electricity made and gener-
36 ated upon its property between the towns of Old Town and
37 Bradley, and between the towns of Orono and Bradley to
38 and into any towns or cities in the county of Penobscot,

39 State of Maine, and there to use the same in all ways for
40 its own purposes, and there to sell the same for mechanical,
41 manufacturing, heating and said lighting purposes. But
42 nothing herein contained shall be held to authorize said
43 Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company to do a general light-
44 ing business. And said company is also authorized and
45 empowered to sell and supply electricity to any street rail-
46 way company now existing or hereafter to be created.

And said Company is also further authorized and em-
48 powered to carry and conduct electricity made and gener-
49 ated upon its property between the towns of Old Town
50 and Bradley and between the towns of Orono and Bradley
51 as aforesaid, to and into any towns or cities in the county
52 of Waldo except the city of Belfast and to use the same
53 in all ways for its own purposes and there to sell the same
54 for manufacturing and heating purposes, but not for elec-
55 tric lighting or street railway purposes, in the county of
56 Waldo, except to the Searsport Electric Light Company or
57 its successors. But nothing herein contained shall prevent
58 any corporation which may hereafter be organized under
59 the general law from generating, selling, distributing or
60 supplying electricity in any of the towns or cities in the
61 county of Waldo.'
