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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter ninety-three of the  
Revised Statutes relating to the recording of personal prop-  
erty mortgages and sales.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter ninety-three of the Re-  
vised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the fol-  
lowing words 'provided there be a town or plantation in the  
county organized as aforesaid adjoining such unorganized  
place, and if there be no such town or plantation organized  
as aforesaid in the county such mortgage shall be recorded  
in the office of the Register of Deeds for the Registry Dis-  
trict in which said unincorporated place is located,' so that  
the last sentence of said section as amended shall read as  
follows:

‘Sect. 1. If any mortgagor resides in an unorganized  
11 place, the mortgage shall be recorded in the oldest adjoining  
12 town or plantation, organized as aforesaid, in the county,  
13 provided there be a town or plantation in the county organ-  
14 ized as aforesaid, and if there be no such town or plantation  
15 organized as aforesaid in the county such mortgage shall be  
16 recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for the Regis-  
17 try District in which such unincorporated place is located.’
