STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy
Tribe of Indians.

Whereas, the State of Maine holds in trust for the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians a certain large sum of money, to wit, thirty-three thousand one hundred forty dollars and seventy cents, and whereas all funds appropriated by the Seventy-third Legislature for the care, maintenance and relief of said tribe have been expended for the purposes and in the manner prescribed by law, and because of the lack of available funds, said tribe may fall into distress and be deprived of proper food, shelter and clothing.

Whereas, by reason of the foregoing facts the appropriation called for in this resolve is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and in the opinion of this legislature constitutes an emergency as contemplated by the constitution, be it therefore

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury, to be
2 expended under the direction of the governor and council,
3 to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for the
4 benefit of said tribe for the years nineteen hundred and
5 eleven and nineteen hundred and twelve as follows:

For May dividends each year.....	\$400 00
November dividends each year.....	400 00

Agricultural purposes each year.....	400 00
Plowing each year	100 00
